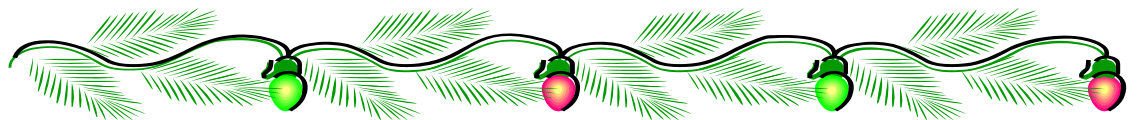

for a little Friday fun!

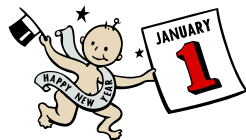


Holiday Office Closings

Snow Removal In The Village



Our Street Department does a great job of keeping the snow plowed during the winter months, but we need your help!

There is no parking on the Village Streets from 3:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. so that the plows can maneuver through the streets. They are often plowing by 4:00 a.m. The Village Ordinance states that your vehicle may be impounded and towed away if you do not have it moved out of the way.

Also, a reminder that you are responsible for snow removal on sidewalks in front of your home or business. Please do not push snow from your personal driveway into the streets.

Park Reservations

Reservations for the Village Park for 2016 may be made by calling the Village Office at 422-1779 beginning on Monday, January 4, 2016 at 8:00 a.m. Please do not leave messages with reservations over the holiday weekend as they will not be accepted.



There is no charge to village residents to reserve the park, however, there is a refundable \$20 key deposit required for each day. A \$25 rental fee will be charged to all non-Village residents. Keys must be picked up by Thursday prior to the date you have the park reserved and be returned by the following Monday.
