New Garage Sale Ordinance

Spring is just around the corner and time for garage sales to begin. In brief, here are the highlights:

- \Rightarrow Three days is the maximum time limit for one sale.
- \Rightarrow Three sales per location per calendar year.
- ⇒ A permit must be obtained from the Clerk's Office (there is no charge to hold a garage sale).
- \Rightarrow Signs may be put up, but must be removed after the sale period.
- ⇒ All sale items MUST be stored indoors from 9:00 p.m. - 7:00 a.m.

The ordinance may be viewed in full online or at the Village Office.

We Now Accept Credit Card Payments!

You can now pay your water/sewer payments, property taxes, building permits and electrical permits with a credit card online by visiting our website at barodavillage.org. Just look for the "pay bills" link.

As always, you may also pay with a check, cash or money order either in the mail drop it in the drop box or in the Village office.

Park Reservations

Reservations for the Village Park for 2018 may be made by calling the Village Office at 422-1779.

NEW THIS YEAR: There is a \$25 rental fee for Village residents, and a \$50 fee for non-Village residents. Groups of 50 or larger will be charged \$75.

As always, there is a refundable \$20 key deposit is also required. Keys must be picked up at the Village Office by Thursday prior to the date you have the park reserved and be returned or left in the drop box at the Municipal Building within three (3) days after reserved date.
