New Garage Sale Ordinance

Spring is just around the corner and time for garage sales to begin. In brief, here are the highlights:

1) Three days is the maximum time limit for one sale.



- 2) Three sales per location per calendar year.
- A permit must be obtained from the Clerk's Office (there is no charge to hold a garage sale).
- 4) Signs may be put up, but must be removed after the sale period.
- 5) All sale items MUST be stored indoors
