From the Village President, Bob Getz

It's May and time for spring updates. The Village Council passed a House Numbering Ordinance that took effect January 25, 2018. All homes within the Village are now required to have house numbers posted in a conspicuous spot and in a contrasting color that is clearly visible. This will make it easier for any emergency vehicles to find your home faster when time is critical.

The Village is in the process of applying for a loan/grant of approximately 1.8 million dollars for the purpose of extending the streetscape south to the Industrial Park road. It also includes the industrial park road and infrastructure and sidewalk. The industrial park is sold except for one 2-acre lot so the need for the road is critical. The water main from Church Street south needs to be replaced so it makes sense to do the streetscape since the road will be tore up anyway.

There will be a public hearing on May 7th at 6:30 p.m., before our regular council meeting to share the information that we have so far.

We are also very happy to have our very own Farmer's Market in downtown this summer! Beginning Saturday, May 12th and every weekend from, 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. at the old school field. You can enter from, 2nd or 3rd Streets.



New Garage Sale Ordinance

Spring is just around the corner and time for garage sales to begin. In brief, here are the highlights:

- ⇒ Three days is the maximum time limit for one sale.
- ⇒ Three sales per location per calendar year.
- ⇒ A permit must be obtained from the Clerk's Office (there is no charge to hold a garage sale).
- ⇒ Signs may be put up, but must be removed after the sale period.
- ⇒ All sale items MUST be stored indoors from 9:00 p.m. - 7:00 a.m.

The ordinance may be viewed in full online or at the Village Office.

Reservations for the Village Park for 2018 may be made by calling the Village Office at 422-1779.

NEW THIS YEAR: There is a \$25 rental fee for Village residents, and a \$50 fee for non-Village residents. Groups of 50 or larger will be charged \$75.

As always, there is a refundable \$20 key deposit is also required. Keys must be picked up at the Village Office by Thursday prior to the date you have the park reserved and be returned or left in the drop box at the Municipal Building within three (3) days after reserved date.
