

Ordinance No. 201

VILLAGE OF BARODA, BERRIEN COUNTY, STATE OF MICHIGAN

**AMENDMENT TO CODE OF ORDINANCES
(Village Council Compensation)**

**ADOPTED: September 8, 2026
(Effective: September 21, 2026)**

An Ordinance amending Chapter 2, Article II of the existing ordinances regarding compensation of the Village Council and officers and employees.

THE VILLAGE OF BARODA, BERRIEN COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Authority.

In accordance with the authority for the establishment of ordinances (MCL 66.1) and the general powers of the Village Council (MCL 67.1) and pursuant to Chapter 1, Section 1-14, the Village of Baroda Ordinances are amended as follows:

SECTION 2. Amended Ordinances.

This Ordinance shall amend Chapter 2, Article II Sections 2-19, 2-20 and 2-21 of the Code of Ordinances, Village of Baroda, Michigan.

SECTION 3. The Newly Amended Ordinances.

Section 2-19 shall be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-19. Compensation.

Each trustee of the Village Council shall be paid \$1,000 per annum plus \$50.00 for each regular meeting or special meeting attended. Payments shall be made quarterly.

The President of the Village Council shall be paid \$18,500.00 per annum plus \$50.00 for each regular meeting attended or special meetings attended.

Pay for Council shall coincide with the beginning of the fiscal year.

Sec. 2-20. Employees Compensation.

The Village Clerk and Village Treasurer are appointed employees pursuant to Ordinance 126. The Clerk and Treasurer and all other employees shall receive a compensation package as established from time to time by council resolution.

Sec. 2-21. Special Meetings.

This section is repealed and of no force or effect.

SECTION 4. Severability.

If any portion or section of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance shall be found to be invalid by a court, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or applications.

SECTION 5. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect on September 21, 2026.

SECTION 6. Publication; Recordation.

This Ordinance or a summary shall be published as required by law in the Herald-Palladium, a newspaper or general circulation in the Village, promptly after its adoption, and shall be recorded in the Ordinance Book of the Village and such recording authenticated by the signatures of the Village President and Village Clerk.
