

Village of Baroda DPW Position Open Public Works Full Time Position

The Village of Baroda is currently looking for a full-time position for the maintenance department. The proper candidate will have a background in light and heavy-duty equipment with the knowledge of using the equipment for day-to-day operations. A CDL License is required for this position, as the full-time employee.

Compensation:

\$18.00 an hour starts off pay with a 90-day review. Paid time off and an excellent benefit package.

Job Duties:

As the full time DPW of the village your responsibilities will include all public works projects, maintenance on all Village equipment, keep streets and parks clean and managed, mow and weed eat all village properties, and snow removal during the winter. Proper candidate will operate a wide range of machinery to get the job done. Working outside in the weather is a must.

Maintenance Garage- The DPW will oversee keeping the garage organized and clean for daily operations. The responsibility of scheduling in projects, ordering of materials, and keeping tools in a well-kept manner. All hours and work done will be recorded by the DPW.

Village streets- DPW is responsible in overseeing keeping the streets clean and safe for all residents. Street sweeping in the summer to snow plowing in the winter, during the winter months overtime and extra hours may be asked to keep the streets clear.

Village Equipment- Complete basic maintenance and repairs on all Village equipment, including oil changes, greasing of all heavy machinery, light duty mechanical work tractors/mowers.

Village infrastructure- DPW is responsible for keeping sewers and drains cleaned out, marking Miss Dig, and keeping all the water department current on any issues. Always current on licensing and testing for all departments.

CDL- DPW responsibility to hold and maintain a CDL license, including all testing and paperwork needed to keep the CDL.

Qualifications- Educational requirements include a high school diploma or equivalent, Basic knowledge of tools, Experience in maintenance or construction preferred, and basic skills in all applications of machinery and tools.

Ability to use good judgement while out in the field, communicate, and build a working relationship with all the Village employees.

Physical Demands- The position requires the employee to regularly stand and or walk frequently, lifting everything from light trash to heavy branches in the day-to-day operation. The employee may go from heavy machinery to light duty tractors to working in the sewer area. This position does lots of mowing and sitting on tractors day to day so being in shape is a plus. A seasoned worker is best since most of the job is outside.
